

Ground Guide

The Main Stand is overlooked by a church spire, whilst opposite a tall, well-tended hedge borders the entire length of the open side. Glebe Park is the only ground in Europe with a hedge surrounding its perimeter. This side has a small open terrace only a couple of steps high and there are a number of floodlight pylons running down the front of it.

The Main Stand is a small all seated covered stand, which straddles the half way line with a capacity of 290 and was built in 1981 to make the ground wider by two yards and replaced a similar looking wooden stand.



The Hedge End

At one end is the Cemetery End terrace, which is covered and has a number of supporting pillars they were going to build a stand at Cemetery End but constraints of the hedge and the dead at the back meant a new covered enclosure could only be built.



Cemetery End (Brechin City)

Opposite, is the latest addition to the ground, the smart looking Trinity Road Stand which was built in the early 1990's, it is a covered all seated stand, which seats nearly 1,228 spectators and it is unusual, in being setback some distance from the pitch and sits upon a raised bank. There is the Stables Bar which is good for a pre-match pint in Market Street as well as the Hotel and in Swan Street there is the Brechin Arms, the bottom of City Road there is the City Bar or at the old Rail Station there is the Park Arms on Park Road all are 10 minutes from the ground so just park up at the ground and use google maps to find them.

Driving Directions



Take the A90 from the South take the B966 Edzell and Brechin junction and take the first exit at the roundabout and straight on at the next into Trinity Road and follow it into Brechin and the ground is signposted on the left.

From the North take the A935 for Montrose and Arbroath and at the roundabout take the second exit onto the B966 Trinity Road and the ground is signposted on the left. By using these routes saves you going through Brechin Town centre and its quicker getting home.
