The league was formed in 1964, as a merger of the East Anglian League and the Norfolk & Suffolk League (established 1897) and had a transitional season in 1964–65 before settling down to a regular format for the 1965–66 season of four divisions for first teams and three for reserves. A further division for first teams was added for 1966–67, and that format has remained unchanged with the winners of the Premier Division is also known as the Sterry Cup winners and are eligible for promotion to the Eastern Counties Football League (Level 9 and 10 on the Pyramid System).
