The stadium has two seated stands on either side of the long edges of the pitch, although these do not stretch the length of the pitch. One on side, the stand is built into the clubhouse, the overhang of which provides cover against the elements.

In addition to these stands, there are designated covered standing areas behind each goal, and a metal barrier which stretches around the circumference of the playing surface. In total, the capacity of Parkside is around 3,500, with seating for 500 people.

The playing surface itself is a 4th Generation artificial grass pitch. However, Parkside also has a secondary natural grass full-sized pitch, as well as two mini pitches which are also fully grass.

Driving to the Ground



From M25, Northbound (anti-clockwise) then exit at Junction 31 and take a left into ship Lane and follow the instructions below from Ship Lane.



From M25, Southbound (clockwise) take the exit for the A13 West, then at the roundabout take the second exit, keep in the left lanes, then follow the road right at the lights into Ship Lane, at the end and at the mini roundabout take the second exit into the High Street, then at the roundabout take the first exit then first left for Park Lane and he ground is on the right with plenty parking.

The ground has a capacity of 3,000 with 224 seated in the main stand all the turnstiles are all in Blunts Wall Road. The eastern edge is covered terrace up to the half way line, then a small stand with 200 seats and standing enclosure beside it.



The western side has seen the most development in recent years and the central 70% or so is now covered with seats in most of it and terracing in the southern end. The south end has a similar stand to the north behind the goal, plus some open terracing. The clubhouse is open before, at half time and after matches. It's not particularly big but it's not bad, has a good

atmosphere and a huge Sky TV screen. Behind the north end is a small covered terrace and some open terrace.



Driving to the Ground



From the M25 (J29) take the A127 to the Basildon/Southend and take the first exit from the North and the fourth from the South at the roundabout on to the A127 after two miles take the Dunton exit and at the roundabout take the first exit and then take the first right onto Dunton Road.

Then take the first left into Rectory Road and then at the Small War Memorial Cross take a left into Clock House Road and then take the first left after the Farm shop on your left into Blunts Wall Road and the ground is on the right with the car park second on the right.

Train to **Billericay Railway Station** and take the **Essex bus 9 coach** to London Road from outside the railway station, then take a left at the end of the road, then walk down to Fairfield Garage and at the crossroads take a right, into Tye Common Road and Blunts Wall Lane is second right with the entrance to the ground on the right after about 50 yards.

Driving to the Ground



The centre of Brentwood is approximately 1½ miles from junction 28 of the M25 so at the roundabout from the North take the second exit and from the South take the fourth exit. Take the signs for the A1023 Brentwood till you get to Wilsons Corner of the High Street, then at the lights turn left into Ongar Road. At the third mini roundabout take the right-hand fork into Doddinghurst Road. The Brentwood Centre is a further half a mile, on the right just after the A12 Bridge.



Once you enter the Centre the football ground entrance is in the far right hand corner of the car park. There are normally vast amounts of parking available, but beware when special events are taking place at the Brentwood Centre, as the car park can then become very congested.

From the A23 exit at the junction with the A2300 and follow this towards Burgess Hill then at the St Paul's College roundabout turn left and then straight over at the next one. At the third roundabout take the third exit into London Road (Signposted town centre). At the next roundabout, turn left into Leylands Road and after you have gone over a roundabout take a left at next mini roundabout into Leylands Park follow the road round the bend then take the first right and the ground is hidden behind the houses on the right and there is a small car park beside the ground.

Take the M25 to junction 29 then at the roundabout and take the first exit onto the A127 then take the A176 exit and take the first exit at the roundabout and go straight on at the next two and at the third take the first exit onto the A1321.



Then at the second roundabout take the third exit onto the A132 then at the next take the second exit onto the A13 then at the end keep in the left lane which will take you onto the A130 (Canvey Way). At the next roundabout take the second exit onto the B1014 and go through two roundabouts. You will enter the one-way system where you need to keep left. You will eventually pass the Transport Museum on your right and just after it turn right at the mini roundabout into Park Lane for the ground and there is plenty of free parking around the ground.





Take the M25 to junction 30 and at the roundabout take the third exit and take A13 towards Southend, follow this road until you reach the end then follow the above directions.

Take the M25 to Junction 10 take the A3 exit to London (S W)/ Guildford/ Kingston then take the first exit at the roundabout for Kingston/ Esher then merge onto Portsmouth Rd/A3, follow the signs for the A3 on the Kingston By Pass then at the roundabout take the fourth exit into Kingston Road, then go straight through at the next roundabout and then take a left into Cheam Road after about 800 yards at the lights. Continue on the road for about 3 ½ mile till you come to AK cars and St Barns Church there turn left up the hill then at the T Junction turn right onto Westmead Road then at the Mini roundabout at May Tree Pub take the first exit the entrance to the ground is down a small alley about 150 yards on your right

Take the M25 to Junction 7 (Signposted Croydon) and follow the A23 past the old Croydon Airport before taking a left after a few miles onto the A232. Follow this road for a couple of miles, passing Beddington Park on your right before you enter Carshalton. Pass through the High Street, passing the two large ponds on your right and then take the next right into West Street. Pass the Racecourse and Hope pubs and then immediately after you pass under the railway bridge take a left into Colston Avenue. The entrance to the ground is down a small alley about 150 yards on your right. This is a busy and narrow road so I would avoid parking down here – there is a car park at the ground (£2) or park on West Street.

Maidstone Road has a mix of traditional and the unusual. One large stand runs along one side of the pitch with some basic benches, whilst opposite is a small seated stand proudly displaying the club's name. It is behind the west goal that the unusual white structure takes your interest. One end is the club bar with a huge vaulted roof.

Driving to the Ground



From the North exit the M25 at Junction 2 and take the A2 and go onto the M2 and leave at junction 3, and follow directions for Chatham & Town Centre. You will then pass a Homebase & Toys 'R' US on the left-hand side. Continue straight over the roundabout and then there is a split in the road, where you bear right for Chatham onto Maidstone Road. Follow this, continuing straight over the crossroads and you will see a petrol station on the left then take a right into Bournville Road which is opposite the petrol station on the left with the ground entrance is first left.

If you are coming South take the M25 take Junction 5 onto the M26 then merge onto the M20 then exit at junction 6 and head on the A129 towards Chatham and then as north once you pass over the M2. Parking is free at the ground and the surrounding roads.

The Stadium ground has been upgraded over the last few years plus the car park has been repaired. Inside the ground has two stands with the main stand has a few rows of seats and has a bar behind, with the entrance and exit via the old tunnel. The view is obstructed by pillars and also sits bizarrely some 5 metres behind the touchline, whilst either side of it the perimeter fence sits on the touchline. On the opposite side is a small stand again sat back from the touchline and around the rest of the stadium is simple standing behind the barrier.

From the M25 exit the motorway off junction 25 and then head north on the A10 then At the next roundabout turn right onto the A121 Winston Churchill Way then at next roundabout turn left into the High Street. Pass under the Railway Bridge and take the next left into Theobalds Lane with the ground is 200 yards down this road on the righthand side.

NOTE: On the way out you can continue down Theobalds Lane and turn left onto the dual carriageway, then straight over the roundabout for the M25

The ground has been well designed and comfortable with a capacity of 4,100 as well as being probably the most environmentally friendly football ground so far constructed in the UK. The main stand has just three rows, seating in total for 640 spectators and a glassed area at the rear, which contains the clubhouse bar. Like the rest of the stadium, the roof is situated quite high above the spectator area and has a slight oval angle to it. The other three sides of the stadium are small terraced areas.



Opposite the Main Stand the Wooden Man sculpture stands on the terrace, if segregation is in force then away fans are housed in the Car Park End which has a capacity of 700 supporters and in addition 38 seats are made available on one side of the Main Stand by the Car Park End.

Driving to the Ground



From the North

Take Junction 6A on to the M25 After going over the Dartford Crossing (which costs £2), leave the motorway at Junction 1b and take the left-hand slip road for A225 Dartford. At the roundabout at the end of the slip road above the motorway turn right the Esso garage onto the A225 (Princess Road) towards Dartford. Go straight across the next roundabout, passing a BP garage on the right. At the next set of traffic lights then turn left into Darenth Road and then take the second left into Grassbanks for the stadium. There are about 300 spaces if full

then drive down to the Bluewater Shopping Centre they give you three hours free parking and then use the transport directions to the ground.





Leave the M25 at Junction 2 (A2/Dartford A225). At the roundabout below the roundabout take the Dartford A225 exit. At the next roundabout take the 1st exit by the Esso garage onto the A225 towards Dartford. Go straight across the next roundabout, passing a BP garage on the right. At the next set of traffic lights then turn left into Darenth Road and then take the second left into Grassbanks for the stadium. There are about 300 spaces if full then drive down to the Bluewater Shopping Centre they give you three hours free parking and then use the transport directions to the ground. The ground try to direct you to another shopping centre close by but they charge so why pay.

Train to **Dartford Railway Station** from there exit the station walk straight ahead towards the Orchard Theatre/Shopping Centre. Do not cross the bridge but take the steps/ramp down to the Bus stops, then take the **London Transport Fastrack B bus** service towards Bluewater/Gravesend and alight at the Princes Park stop. Buses run every 10 mins during the day, with a slightly longer interval in the evenings and is £4.00 return with **Arriva Kent Thameside**







The alternative is to take the train to **Ebbsfleet International** then exit the station and take the **London Transport Fastrack B bus** service towards Bluewater/Dartford and alight at the

Princes Park stop. The Buses run every 10 mins during the day, with 20 minutes in the evenings and is £4.00 return with **Arriva Kent Thameside**.

Where to Drink

There is a bar at the ground The Defluo Bar which is specifically for the use of away fans with the entrance to it is in the car park at the away end of the stadium.

The nearest pub to the ground is the Ivy Leaf on Darenth Road, which is about a five-minute walk away from the stadium entrance turn right along Darenth Road, cross over the main road at the traffic lights and the pub is on the right a few yards up the road and there is also the Malt Shovel, which also does food with both these pubs are listed in the CAMRA Good Beer Guide.

Otherwise Dartford Town Centre is around 15 minutes' walk away, where there are plenty of pubs to be found. Wat Tyler on the High Street, the Paper Moon opposite and another the Flying Boat on Spital Street.

The Tommy Jover Main Stand even though it has been built onto the front of an office building which is all seated stand is elevated, that you have to climb a small set of stairs to enter it. Once there you are rewarded with excellent views of the pitch as there are no supporting pillars to contend and the stand that contains the Social Club. The area is covered and the roof has a gable on top which includes a clock. DHFC is proudly emblazoned below it.



The Champion Hill ground is largely open and has mostly flat standing areas on three sides, with just a small portion (a few steps high) of terracing towards the rear. Both the East and West ends are uncovered, as well as most of the Southside, although this does have a small portion of cover and terrace located at its centre.

Visiting fans are made welcome and a sign of this is that fans are very rarely segregated at the ground. You can also enjoy some Carribean Cuisine inside the stadium from the 'Shak'; the same people who have their legendary food place at Tooting & Mitcham FC,

Take the M1 and at the end take the first exit at the roundabout onto Edgware Road then follow Cricklewood Broadway (A5) for the next four miles turn left at Marble Arch then follow the road right into Oxford Street into Park Lane and at Hyde Park Corner take a right into Duke of Wellington Place then just under 100 yards take a left into Grosvenor Place (A302) then at the Victoria Theatre take the right lane at the lights then left onto Vauxhall Bridge Road (A202).

Then just after Vauxhall Station take a right into Durham Street then take a left into Haleyford Road past the Oval cricket ground and continue into Camberwell and just after the Lesuire Centre (on your left) take a right into Camberwell Grove and then at the T-Junction do a right left into Dog Kennell Hill then take the first left onto Edgar Kail Way then just after the entrance to Sainsbury take a right into the car park for the ground which is shared with the Health club.





Take the M25 to Junction 2 then at the roundabout take the third exit onto the A2 then follow the road to the exit for the A2 ramp C to Central London/ Peckham then at the roundabout take the first exit onto Shooters Hill Road (A2) and follow it for just over two miles before turning left after New Cross railway Station into Amersham Road (A2) the first right onto Parkfield Road (A2) then a right onto Lewisham Way (A2) and then just under a mile left onto St Marys Street and follow the road round the church then at the bottom take a right into Evelina Road.

Park View Road, home of Welling United FC and Erith & Belvedere FC. The Wings moved to Park View Road when a fire destroyed their ground in Eltham and they moved into the old

Bexley United ground which had just gone defunct, unlike many ground sharing arrangements this is a permanent.

The sale of the Deres old ground of Park View provided funds to completely redevelop one side of Park View Road, where Erith's headquarters are now maintained, completely separate from those of Welling United.

Park View Road is one of those 'traditional' football grounds adjacent to the main high street, with a capacity of 4.000 with 1,070 seated around the ground. Erith's own new facilities adjacent to the main stand, replaced aging terracing that was partly covered by a rusting shelter supported by a fragile-looking arrangement of scaffolding poles. The Welling clubhouse is quite small and its entrance is immediately ahead of the turnstiles as you enter the ground.

The Main Stand was built in the late 1950 by the now defunct Bexley United and was extended in the 1960 and this has now been updated to bring it up to Conference stands in March 2014 which was nearly have them sent down to the Isthmian League if it hadn't been fixed.



East Stand

Opposite the Main Stand is the much newer East Stand which was opened in 2002. Also known as the Cricket Club side this stand is all covered and all seated. It has a capacity of 600. However, it only runs half the length of the pitch towards the Danson Park End and has a pair of pillars on either side which also serve as floodlight pylons. One of these could impede your view of the playing action down at the High Street End. At one side of the East Stand is the building which houses a social club and adjacent to this is a flat standing area. away fans are allocated the whole of the East Stand and the Danson Park Terrace. The terrace is open to the elements so if the weather forecast is not good, then use the East Stand, as they are under roof. There are 600 seats with around 400 standing places available on Danson Park End.

Both ends are open terraces. The larger of these is at the Danson Park End, which looks quite picturesque with a number of large trees behind it. Opposite is the smaller High Street End. This end is located very close to the main road and passengers on the upper deck of passing buses can see into the ground as they pass the ground. There is some netting at the back of the terrace to help prevent balls being kicked over.







The ground was opened in 1935 and the Lane is set in a quite area on the town, the Social End is uncovered and opposite is a small covered terrace, at the Sports Club End, which has a small electric scoreboard on its roof.

On the North side of the ground is a small covered terrace, being a few steps high, which runs for around half the length of the pitch. On the other side is a small covered seated Main Stand which has 300 seats that uses two flag poles as part of the roof supports. Winch Field, aka The Safety Net Stadium boasts different styled four stands, floodlights and a well-appointed clubhouse which is regularly hired out for functions. The ground sits on the site of the former Winch's brick yard, a Herne Bay landmark since Victorian times.

The one stand that strikes you as unusual is the main stand. It is a large blue building, next to the bar, and houses the dressing rooms and dugouts.
